7-day self-isolation requirement	No	No	Yes Remaining in isolation is not compulsory for 12-18 year olds that are travelling with a vaccinated/recovered parent or legal representative and present a certificate of a negative PCR test done up to 72h before arriving in Estonia or a negative antigen-RTD test done up to 24h before arriving in Estonia. The test can also be done immediately after arriving in Estonia, in that case it is obligatory to stay in isolation until the negative result comes in.
